

## VIDEO PRESENTATION CRITERIA

### TOPIC

- Teaching clinical examination, therefore the examination of a patient after graduating.
- How are the concepts of clinical examination and osteopathic diagnosis of a patient's presenting problems taught in undergraduate and postgraduate teaching?
- Presentation of the way of teaching the clinical examination à how do the students learn the examination
- Contents the What, How and Why of teaching a diagnostic examination

### REQUIREMENTS

- The video and its presentation must be in the English language
  - ideally with subtitles at all time, for better understanding
  - presenter from the school fluent in English should be present, to supervise the video, to answer questions if there are any and contribute to the central evaluation
- Video length: max. 10 minutes
- Format: MP4, AVI
- No detailed description of the school is needed, other than its name, location(s), number of students and when it was founded
- School's logo should be visible in the upper right or left corner at all time
- The file name should be the name of the school
- The name of the person speaking in the video should be blended in at the beginning of their appearance.
- Quality: 'Music' and words are loud enough to hear; images are in focus, lighting appropriate, camera work is steady.
- Content: Subject is introduced, viewers' attention is caught and held, viewers could easily follow, material is appropriate and in accordance with the content expectations.
- Creativity: Interesting use of camera angle, close up and distance shots enhance video.
- Style and Organization: Video content is organized and flows. Transition between "scenes" is logical and effective, background distractions are minimal.

### SUBMISSION

- Videos should be submitted before **September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018**
  - Upload to *vimeo.com* with a password: OsEAN.OF.2018
  - Send the link to the OsEAN Office per mail.
- Once your video is accepted, deliver it on a USB stick to the secretary at the beginning of the Open Forum on October 18<sup>th</sup>.
