Intention and patient/practitionner interactions through palpation












RESULTS / FEED-BACK: Palpation and sensitivity skills: a specific class

Teachers' quality survey: retrospective over 3 years

330 students followed the complete systemic educational program

Faster and easier integration and learning process of all students

More homogeneous and highly skilled classes

Improvement in perception and sensitivity: highly skilled students

Material used: Questionnaires





CONCLUSION: Palpation and sensitivity skills: a specific class

Better quality in students' sensitivity and perception

More effective learning process

Integration of a global vision of the patient from the very first steps of this systemic educational program

Limits and improvement perspectives:
